Call to Order:

- 1. Jacques brought the meeting to order at 10:00 am.
- 2. We had a quorum consisting of a minimum of 3 directors and most of members (11)

President's report:

- There will be a Fall and Spring AGM.

- Seven (7) races were accepted last season. Ten is too much for most.
- Our third Academy is going well with Top Karting. Great success.

Schedule:

- Sylvain explains the next Coupe de Montreal schedule. 6 events as a draft. Question is if we want to make any adjustments for our NCKC races:
- Selected NCKC events need to consider 4 and 2 stroke, each with their own classes (i.e. Junior, Senior, etc.). All members need to have fun at the tracks
- Question by Daniel Lalonde: race #7, can we do this in ON?
 - Answer by Jacques: "Yes, it is possible."
 - Other tracks were discussed as fun (i.e. MoSport summer Fest, Morrisburg) but some found unsuitable (i.e. Karters Korner)
 - Discussed amongst members: Drivers should consider tyres changes if they visit other races
- The Club is not forcing anyone to stay with the proposed NCKC races. But there is an advantage for new drivers.
- Extensive conversation on possible race schedules. Continued conversation and race proposals will be on our Facebook page

Mayor's cup:

• Jacques thanks Top Karting for hosting the Mayor's Cup, it was very well executed.

Treasurer report:

- Jacques explains the cost of the NCKC fees; race day fuel, transponders, club t-shirt, lunch (on Flintstone BBQ) & drinks, are all included for the season.
- The "partial season / day passes" membership was explained. No questions from members

Budget / Fees:

- Jacques presents the Budget:
 - We are unsure on how many members we will get. If 15 members, \$2800.
 - No sponsorship
 - Jacques presents the expenses
 - We did have other revenue, renting of transponders
 - o ASN affiliation fee \$200
 - o Director insurance \$350 per year. This allows NCKC to give drivers a license
 - o Karelo registration website fees waived because we are non-profit
 - Trailer insurance taken out of/covered by ASN
- Overall, budget is in the plus.
